

Camp Sun 'N Fun 2023 Packing List

Below is a packing list of suggested items that campers should bring with them for their stay at camp. Space is limited, so please pack their belongings in a tote, suitcase or trunk so that it can be easily stored under or at the foot of the bed.

Linens

Sleeping bag or blanket (warm) with sheet set (recommended)

Pillow and pillowcase

Plastic sheet and extra set of sheets (if your camper is prone to accidents)

Bath towel, washcloth and pool towel

Clothing

Change of clothes, socks and underwear for each day of camp

Two pairs of shoes (at least one pair closed-toe)

Aqua shoes for pool and shower (our pool has a scratchy bottom)

Pajamas/robes/slippers

Sweatshirt/sweater/or jacket

At least one pair of pants (sweats/jeans/slacks)

Raincoat/slicker/rain poncho

Bathing suit(s), cover-up or t-shirt

Hat

Miscellaneous

Medications in original bottles (see medication check-in procedures)

All necessary toiletries

Sunscreen and Bug/insect repellent (WITH DEET)

Activity Book

Flashlight

Dirty Laundry Bag

Any necessary adaptive equipment, incontinent briefs, rubber pants/swim diaper or dietary supplements.

Cell Phones/Tablets/Devices

- If you choose to send your camper with any of the above devices, camp is not responsible for damage or theft.
- Please ensure your camper is capable of caring for their items. Counselors will not be responsible for retrieving them or keeping track of them.
- Camp is not responsible for ensuring that phones are charged or being concerned with ensuring that camper's answer phone calls from parents/caregivers. If you wish to talk with your camper you can be sure to reach them by calling our main number. 856-629-4502 (during business hours)
- Keep in mind that camp is a place to get in touch face to face and that a phone will only be a distraction.
